

Travel Advisory for Indian Citizens living in the Republic of Haiti

The Embassy of India in Santo Domingo, is concurrently accredited to the Republic of Haiti. Because of prevailing security situation in Haiti including violent protests, looting, robbery, cholera disease, etc, Embassy advises Indian citizens living in Haiti to remain vigilant and informed at all times, keep movements to a minimum, take all precautions and regularly review departure options.

2. There are currently no Indian diplomats in country and Consular support is not available in Haiti.
