Q.1 Are the programs offered by Indian institutions recognised internationally?

A. All Indian universities and institutions offering degrees in professional and technical courses are recognised globally with the quality assurance given by national-level statutory bodies, namely NIRF and NAAC.

Q.2 What is the Visa Application process?

A. Applicants should have proof of admission to a full-time regular academic course in a reputed/recognized educational institution in India and evidence of financial support.

Q.3 Do international students need to take GRE, GMAT, TOEFL, IELTS, or any other test to study in India?

A. While Indian institutes do not insist on such requirements, proficiency in English is a must since the academic programs are taught in English.

Q.4 What are tuition fee waivers?

A. Tuition fee waivers are concessions given by institutes in the range of 100%, 50%, and 25%. The rest of the expenses like food and accommodation are to be borne by the students.
